### **CHRISTIANITY**

Tradition dates its origins from the birth of Jesus of Nazareth circa 3 B.C.E.; or Jesus' Ministry, Death & Resurrection circa 30 – 36 c.e.; Apostolic Ministries circa 30 to 65 C.E. Scholarship dates the Christian movement from post-Resurrection period from 30/36 C.E. to prior to the earliest New Testament Writings 50 C.E. (Saint Paul's Letter to Thessalonica) to last of canonical Christian Testament circa 100 C.E. Others date Christianity's beginnings at the formal break of Jewish followers of Jesus with the synagogue in the years following the Destruction of the Jerusalem Temple circa 70 C.E. up until 132 C.E. – decades which included the issue of a standard Eighteen Jewish Benedictions and Shema and concluded in the year after the Bar Kokhba Revolt when the Tanna (official teachers) outlawed the writings of the early Christians
