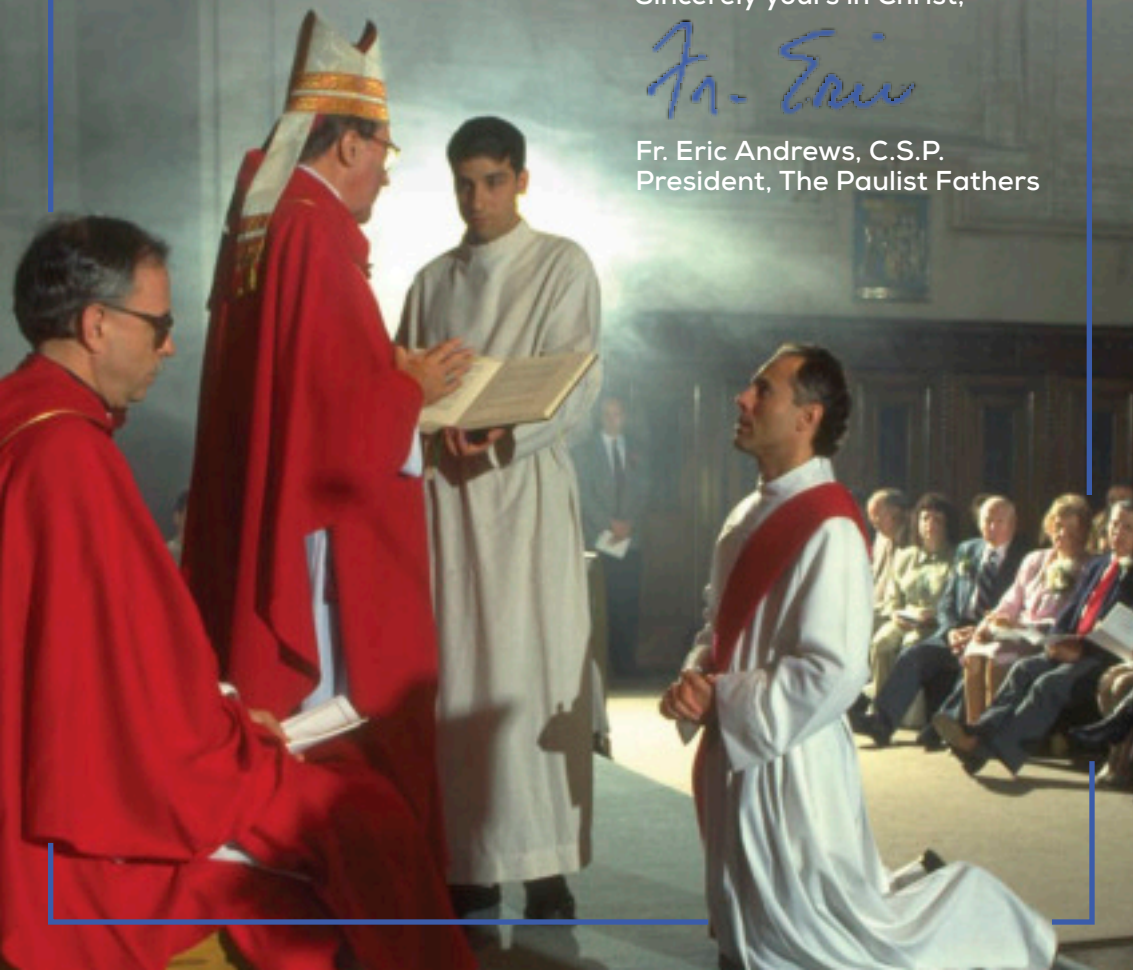

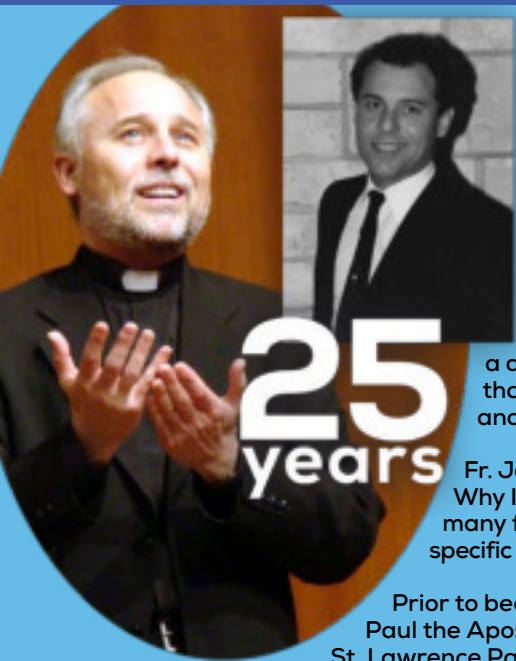

# ORDINATION ANNIVERSARIES

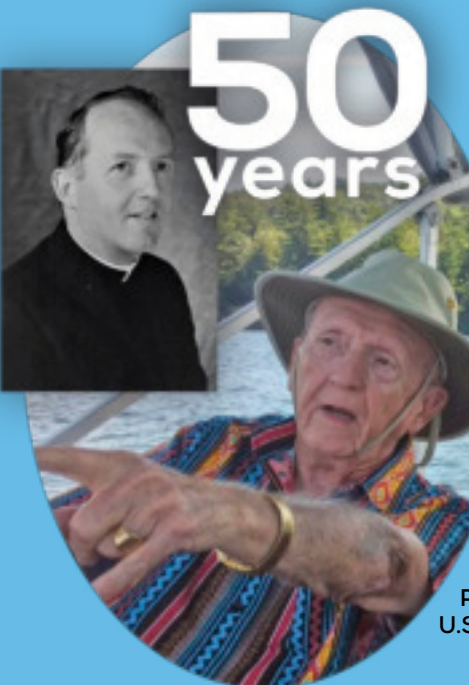


**Fr. James DiLuzio, C.S.P.**  
**Ordained:** May 8, 1993  
**Native Place:** New Jersey  
**Lives Today:** Paulist Motherhouse, NYC

Fr. James is on the Paulist mission band, leading parish missions, retreats and workshops. He is the creator of "Luke Live," a dramatic proclamation of the Gospel of Luke that includes meditations, discussions, preaching and song.

Fr. James also presents "Resurrection Faith: How & Why It Makes a Difference." This mission explores the many facets of death and resurrection as well as the specific details of each Gospel's Resurrection accounts.

Prior to becoming a full-time missionary, he served at St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Community in Los Angeles and St. Lawrence Parish and Newman Center in Minneapolis, MN.



**Fr. Kenneth McGuire, C.S.P.**  
**Ordained:** April 27, 1968  
**Native Place:** Ohio via Kentucky  
**Lives Today:** Palm Springs, CA

Fr. Ken served 18 years at Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles as director of the Cultural Orientation Program for International Ministers.

He also served as director of the University Catholic Center at UCLA; director of the Paulist Institute of Religious Research; director of campus ministry and pastor of St. Mark's University Parish at the University of California at Santa Barbara; and associate pastor of St. Rose of Lima in Layton, UT.

From 1994 to 2011, Fr. Ken was director of St. Mary's of the Lake, the Paulist Fathers' summer retreat at Lake George, NY.

Prior to entering the novitiate, Fr. Ken spent four years in the U.S. Air Force.

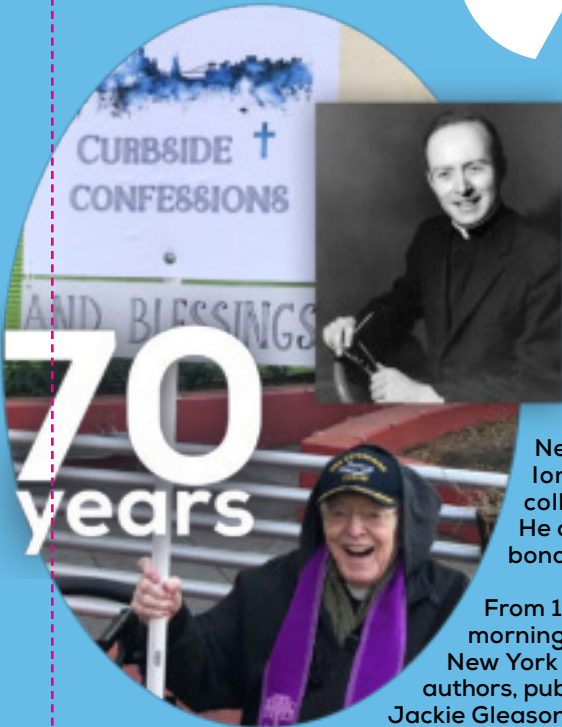


**Fr. Bernard Campbell, C.S.P.**  
**Ordained:** April 27, 1969  
**Native Place:** The Bronx  
**Lives Today:** Paulist Motherhouse, NYC

Fr. Bernard is on the Paulist mission band, leading parish missions, retreats and workshops. His current parish mission is called "Will our Faith Have Children?"

He spent more than 30 years as a Catholic campus minister, serving at the University of California at Berkeley, the University of California at San Diego, the University of Texas at Austin, Clemson University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

He also served as associate pastor of the Cathedral of St. Andrew in Grand Rapids, MI, and pastor of St. Paul the Apostle Church in Horseshoe Bay, TX.



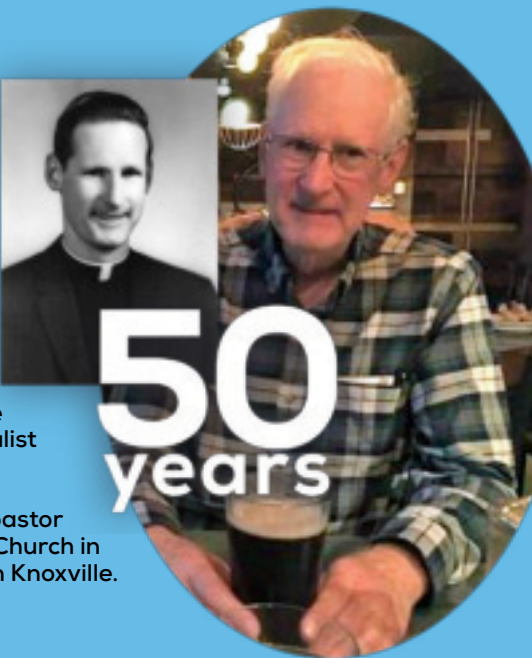
**Fr. James Lloyd, C.S.P.**  
**Ordained:** May 1, 1948  
**Native Place:** Manhattan's West Side  
**Lives Today:** Paulist Motherhouse, NYC

Fr. Lloyd is the oldest-living Paulist Father and, in May, will become the first to celebrate a 70th ordination anniversary.

In the early years of his priesthood, he was a missionary in South Africa.

Fr. Lloyd holds a Ph.D. in psychology from New York University. For 20 years, he worked at Iona College as a professor and director of the college's graduate division of pastoral counseling. He continues to hear confessions and provide pro bono counseling services.

From 1958 to 1973, Fr. Lloyd hosted "Inquiry," a Sunday morning television program on WNBC, NBC's affiliate in New York City. The program featured Fr. Lloyd interviewing authors, public officials and celebrities, including Mother Teresa, Jackie Gleason, William F. Buckley and Florence Henderson.



**Fr. James Haley, C.S.P.**  
**Ordained:** April 27, 1968  
**Native Place:** Nova Scotia  
**Lives Today:** Knoxville, TN

Fr. Jim served as pastor of St. Peter Church in Toronto; Immaculate Conception Church in Knoxville, TN (twice); and St. John University Parish in Morgantown, WV. He also served as director of the Catholic Information Center in Grand Rapids.

Fr. Jim also has served as treasurer of the Paulist Fathers and as superior of the Paulist motherhouse in New York City.

Early in his priesthood, he was associate pastor of St. Rose of Lima in Layton, UT; St. Cyril Church in Tucson, AZ, and Immaculate Conception in Knoxville.

## Donor Profile: Dolores Riedel

We pray in thanksgiving for the life and generosity of Dolores Riedel (1915 - 2015). In late 2017, the Paulist Fathers received a bequest of \$856,000 from Mrs. Riedel's estate.

A parishioner at St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Community in Los Angeles, she was just six months shy of her 100th birthday at the time of her death.

She was born in Minneapolis, MN, to farmer Carl Loesch and Mary Wild Loesch. Early in her life, Mrs. Riedel was an Earl Carroll Showgirl who traveled the country as a dancer.

In later years, she and her husband, Albert Riedel, became successful real estate investors. She enjoyed gardening, dancing, and community activities. At one time, she was president of the Bel Air Homeowners Association.
