



He previously served in Allendale, MI, Minneapolis, Portland, OR, and Columbus, OH.






Fr. Gerard Tully, C.S.P.

Fr. Timothy Tighe, C.S.P.


Ordained: February 22, 1969 Native Place: Union City, NJ Lives Today: New York, NY



In 2011, Dr. Lagowski and her husband, Joseph, were recognized by Bradley University which named the Mund-Lagowski Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry in their honor.
